We encourage the congregation to submit names for candidates to the church secretary until July 31st. Understand the possibility that submitted names may not come back to us from the District for various reasons and circumstances, or may be sent to us and then retracted later.

Board of Directors Update

The Board of Directors and the Finance committee are well on the way towards having a budget to propose for 2018-19 at the annual congregational budget vote. Please be in prayer for your representative brothers and sisters who undertake the tremendous responsibility and time demands every year that this singular process requires, on top of the "regular work" required of our staff and leadership for the day to day function and management of our ministry. Currently we have air conditioning issues that we beg your patience with. There is a nonfunctioning unit in the school that we need to replace before schools starts, and the unit in the sanctuary is not holding temperature. Piedmont Sheet metal advised us thru Don Henderson that we could hopefully limp thru the summer with the sanctuary unit if we keep the brick cool. We have traditionally come over and reduced the thermostat Saturday for services on Sundays, but it has not recently been able to bring the temperature down by the time the Well folks come in for rehearsal at 7:30 and has warmed up as much as 4 degrees in that hour before the Well starts at 8:30am. For the last two weeks we have left the unit run during the week, and it only warmed a couple of degrees during the first service. Please be patient and dress as needed to be prepared to be cool at the beginning of the first service (hopefully) and warming thru the morning as we add bodies and the sun and temperature rises outside."

Persecution Prayer:
In recent years it has been almost impossible for Coptic Christians to obtain a license to build a church. By March of this year there were more than 3,500 pending applications from churches that need to be examined by a government commission set up to verify whether they meet legal requirements. A number of churches that have applied for licenses are attacked by Muslim extremists. However, praise God for a successful rebuilding! Seven years after their previous church was closed by local authorities because of "security reasons", the Coptic community in the Egyptian village of Kom El-Loufy held a first Mass in their new church on July 22, last Sunday. Pray for the Coptic community in Egypt, that their requests for building licenses will be honored and the churches will be built. Pray that the Coptic Christians will continue to witness their faith in the midst of the persecution they face.
