Mite Sunday

Just a reminder that **today** is Mite Sunday. Based on the Biblical account of the widow's mite (Luke 21:1–4), the Mite Box is intended for regular contributions of "mites" — offerings above and beyond the support given to congregations and the LCMS. Mite Box contributions amount to millions of dollars that fund district and national [mission grants](#) and implement the LWML program.

LWML 2019 National Convention

Our local LWML members, Kathleen Sawicki (& Bruce, van driver), Chery Wulfert (District President), Fran Johnson, and Kay Bowman (& Larry, Luggage carrier) attended the National Convention in Mobile, AL on June 20-23, 2019.

The LWML welcomed 3,104 people with 691 "1st timers" under the Theme "In Praise to the Lord". Delegates to the 38th Biennial Convention adopted a \$2,100 [mission goal](#) for the 2019-2021 biennium. This by the Grace of God will fund 21 mission grants during the next 2 years. Last biennium's goal of \$2M was exceeded!!!

The following grants were chosen to be funded over the next biennium. These are the top 5, the entire list is posted on the board in the Social Hall:

1. Water and the Word for Rural Schools in Kenya, \$80k
2. Teach Me Too – Preschoolers with Learning Needs in Austin (LSEM), \$100K
3. Mission Outreach for At-Risk Young Women in Africa, \$100k
4. God's Grace for This Generation (LAMP), \$100K
5. God's Word Changes Everything (LBT), \$95K

The Voting Body elected Debbie Larson from the Rocky Mountain District as next President.

A newly designed LWML box was unveiled, also be looking for this new box as you empty your box into our larger box each 1s Sunday of every Month.

The LWML is the official Women's auxiliary of the Lutheran Church – Missouri Synod. Since 1942 the LWML has focused on affirming each woman's relationship with Christ, encouraging and equipping women to live out their Christian lives in active mission ministries and to support global missions.
