#### Persecution Prayer:

How many of us think back to Easter 2019 - just a few months ago? Not many. For at least 176 children in Sri Lanka that was a life changing day. Those children lost either one or both of their parents as Islamist extremists bombed three churches and three hotels in Sri Lanka. Some of the structures have been rebuilt. It's not as easy to rebuild lives that were torn apart by this terrorism. Helping the survivors deal with their emotional trauma is the biggest need at the moment, but there are few Christian counselors available. Pray for the survivors, that they can find peace, that God will fill their needs, that they continue to trust in our Lord and Savior during these trying times.
