#### **Pastor's Corner**

Invocation and how it works: The word "Invocation" comes from the word invocate which is also a derivative from vocalis, meaning to voice or give voice. We get the word vocal from this. To invocate or to perform an invocation is to invite via voice or to speak into the presence of. When the pastor does the Invocation he is literally inviting God into the worship service. However, since God is already present, the Invocation is a reminder that we worship in the presence of God as well as being a sign of respect. Anything can be invited into an experience. For the Christian, to worship in the presence of God is the goal of our efforts. We worship the Triune God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, and we begin every service, no matter how small or low key, with the Trinitarian invocation.
