Do you know?Jerry Rowe, age 98, current St. John's member and living at Trinity Elms, attended St. John's Lutheran Church in a 2nd story meeting hall at 200 N. Main St. in 1926. Jerry's sister, Pat Rowe Eury, also a current member of St. John's, was baptized by our first resident Pastor (Melbohm) February 17, 1939 at the **rented parsonage/church** in the 1000 block of Miller St. Pat Rowe was confirmed June 11,1952 by Pastor Rupprecht and received a prayer book from him, which she still has. Side note: Pat stated that the title "Reverend" was used at that time, not "Pastor". Another current member, Arden Lackey, with his parents and siblings, joined St. John's Church in 1945. Stewardship Corner: Time, Talent and Treasure

It is good for us to reflect upon the way we fulfill our role of steward, with regard to these three gifts from God: Time, Talent and Treasure.

Do we spend it in such a way that most of our "time" is for our selfish ends? Do we have a healthy balance in our lives with regard to time?
