### 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary

Do you know....? A small table with a big story will be dedicated today in memory of Lloyd and Gaynelle Rowe, beloved members of St. John's first congregation (1938). This table once stood in St. John's first church on the corner of Queen and Westwood St. When St. John's sold the church to Baptist Hospital (1958) the table was left behind. Some say the "church" was used as a Chapel for Baptist Hospital staff. Maurice Briggs was the Chaplain. When the building was torn down. Maurice Briggs saved the table from destruction by taking it home. Just 2-3 years ago, Maurice called St. John's Church and told the story, adding the fact that he was moving to assisted living and needed to move the table on to someone else. He received Arden Lackey's name to call. Arden and Glenda chatted with Maurice several times and eventually arranged to pick up the table and bring it back to St. John's. The descendants of the Rowe family arranged for the table to be refinished, polished and restored by a local craftsman.
