100th Anniversary

Do you know....The Prayer Shawl Ministry started in 2016. "Early Days -- it was very casual and unofficial. One of Jack Fordham's neighbors at the time was a retired lady who crocheted like crazy -- turning out lovely shawls which were given to Jack who then turned them over to Cecile Honeycutt, Martha Tegler and Dot Cleary who then bestowed them throughout the congregation as they saw a need. Then in 2016 when Pastor Schoolcraft was here at St. Johns with us, the group "officially" came into existence. The group has evolved over the years, waxed and waned in size, but currently the group consists of seven ladies. We take turns meeting in each other's home as this promotes a "warm inviting place" of camaraderie. We talk about a lot of things -- family mostly and what is shared in the group stays in the group -- which makes it special. We also discuss who "needs" a shawl or blanket (for the men) and

we also make the Baptismal blankets. From our hearts we pay for our own yarns that are used and they are all washable yarns which makes them all easy to care for. Stewardship Corner: Use Your Talent to God's Glory

Have you heard about the school for animals that was set up in this forest? All the animals decided it was time to set some criteria for who should be allowed to live in the forest, so a number of them came up with a curriculum that included tree climbing, swimming, flying, and running.
